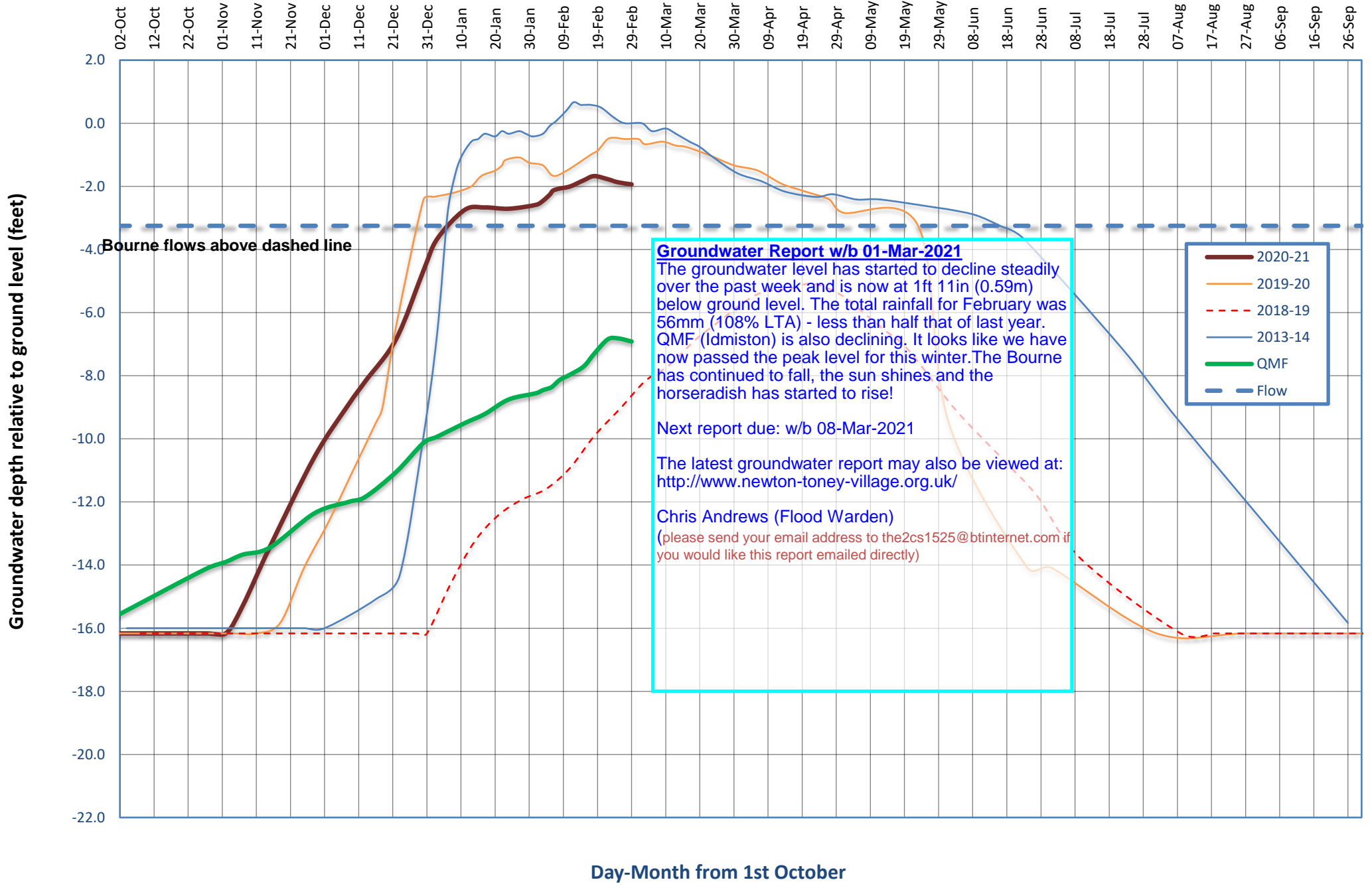


Newton Toney Groundwater Level 2020-21



Groundwater Report w/b 01-Mar-2021
 The groundwater level has started to decline steadily over the past week and is now at 1ft 11in (0.59m) below ground level. The total rainfall for February was 56mm (108% LTA) - less than half that of last year. QMF (Idmiston) is also declining. It looks like we have now passed the peak level for this winter. The Bourne has continued to fall, the sun shines and the horseradish has started to rise!
